Mrs. James Milloy

Ella Grace Lamont, beloved wife of the late James Milloy of Erin Township, died at her home in Toronto, on Monday, January 14, 1963. Mrs. Milloy although not in good health in recent years had been actually ill for only a brief time.

She was in her 85th year. Born in Grey Township in Huron County, she was the daughter of Malcolm and Elizabeth Lamont. She attended a rural school in Grey Township, Listowel High School and Toronto Normal School.

In 1901 Miss Lamont came as the first teacher in the new McKittrick School on the Erin-Garafraxa townline. She taught in this school for four years.

On February 1, 1905 she was

married to James Milloy. Mr. and Mrs. Milloy lived briefly in Garafraxa Township and on the 9th line of Erin Township, and in 1909 moved to lot 31, concession 8, of Erin Township, where they lived until Mr. Milloy's death in 1932. Mrs. Milloy then moved to Toronto where she lived with her daughter, Ella.

She is survived by two daughters Alice (Mrs. Albert Royce), of Guelph, and Ella of Toronto, and a son Archie, also of Toronto. Also by her younger sisters Mrs. William Stevenson of Brussels and Mrs. John Krauter of Ethel and by five grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

The funeral was held from the Butcher Funeral Home,

Hillsburgh, on Thursday afternoon, January 17. Rev. N. Binning, Minister of Armour Heights United Church in Toronto, where Mrs. Milloy was a charter member, officiated.

Her pall bearers were Norman and Ross Stevenson, nephews of Brussels, John Barbour and Ted Ferns, cousins of Garafraxa Township, and Jim Royce and Douglas Milloy grandsons. Temporary entombment was in the Coningsby Mortuary. Burial at Huxley's Cemetery.
